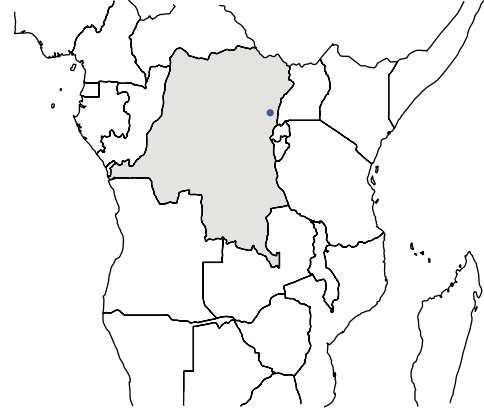

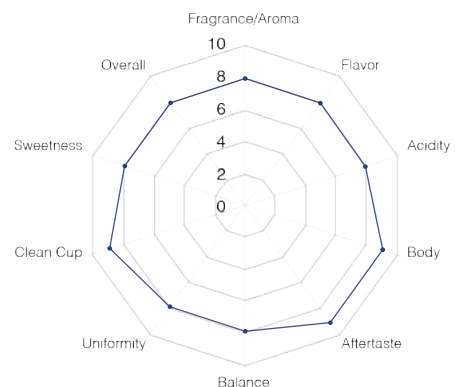


About the Virunga National park
